- Close collaboration with Allegheny County Emergency Services; TRCPA has a seat at the table when the Emergency Operations Center is activated. TRCPA has long-standing relationships with federal, regional, state, and local agencies, including:
 - US Department of Homeland Security
 - FEMA Region III
 - Federal Executive Board
 - PA Region 13 Task Force
 - Allegheny County Emergency Services
 - Allegheny County Local Emergency Planning Committee
 - City of Pittsburgh Office of Emergency Management and Homeland Security
- Participation in an access credentialing initiative, designed to authenticate critical business employees, facilitating their access to restricted areas following a disaster or serious emergency.
- Access to the TRCPANotify system, which is used to convey emergency information (as received from emergency management personnel) to our members (via phone, e-mail, or text). TRCPA members can also 'call for help' from other members – requests for assistance are promptly sent to all members via TRCPANotify to provide mutual aid for whatever resources may be needed.
- Local training sessions for the Certified Business Continuity Planner certification (offered to TRCPA members at a discount).
- A jobs board, where members can post current openings or view the backgrounds of available candidates.
